ORDINANCE NO. 971

AN ORDINANCE OF MT. OLIVER BOROUGH, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF A POLICE MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT THROUGH SHACOG

WHEREAS, MT. OLIVER BOROUGH (hereinafter "Municipality") and SHACOG have entered into and seek to update a police mutual aid agreement setting forth the terms and conditions of the provision of police services when called for by a participating SHACOG municipality; and

WHEREAS, cooperation between the Municipality and the surrounding communities in the exercise and performance of their governmental powers, duties and functions is authorized by the various Acts of the General Assembly, including as may be applicable but not limited to the Borough Code, the Second Class Township Code, the First Class Township Code and the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act; and

WHEREAS, it is recognized that the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, separate and apart from these other Codes, provides for an ordinance related thereto, and the purpose of this ordinance is to conform to the requirements of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Ordained and Enacted by the Governing Body of the Municipality, Allegheny County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby Ordained and Enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

1. Pursuant to the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 53 Pa. C.S.A. Section 2301, et seq., the terms and conditions of a police services mutual aid agreement by and between the Municipality and SHACOG as recommended by the Chief of Police of the Municipality is hereby approved and adopted, said Agreement being substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit

A, which Agreement is incorporated herein and made a part hereof. The Municipality is hereby authorized, by Resolution of the Governing Body adopted at a public meeting, to enter into such an Agreement, on substantially similar terms, with any other particular named surrounding municipality upon recommendation of the Municipality Police Chief. Further, the Municipality is authorized, by resolution, to enter into any extension or extensions of such Agreement.

2. The appropriate authorized officers of the Municipality are hereby authorized to execute and enter into said Police Services Mutual Aid Agreement on behalf of the Municipality and to take all actions and execute all documents necessary to implement said Agreement.

3. Pursuant to the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 53 Pa. C.S.A. § 2307, the following are specified:

- (1) The conditions of the Agreement are set forth in Exhibit A.
- (2) The duration of the term of the Agreement is set forth in Exhibit A.
- (3) The purpose and objectives of the Agreement, including the powers and scope of authority delegated in the Agreement are set forth in Exhibit A.
- (4) The manner and extent of any financing the Agreement are set forth in Exhibit A.
- (5) The organizational structure necessary to implement the Agreement are set forth in Exhibit A.
- (6) The manner in which personal property is to be acquired, managed, licensed or disposed of is set forth in Exhibit A.
- (7) No new entity is created under 53 Pa. C.S.A. § 2307(7) which will have employees.

4. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its enactment.
