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Public Works Report

February 1, 2021 – February 28, 2021

Borough Building:

- Routine facility maintenance (e.g. empty trash, clean/sweep, re-stock supplies).

Trash / Debris:

- Emptied trash cans/spot sweep 3x's per week in the Business District.
- Picked up tires, TVs, debris around Borough.

Traffic / Signs:

Road Maintenance:

- Responded to (14) PA 1 Calls for the month of February.
- Detailed streets according to the new street detail schedule:
 - **Weekly:** Brownsville, Middle, Charles, Goldbach, Hays (Margaret to Brownsville), Margaret (Brownsville to Hays), William, Bertha, Anthony (Ormsby to Walter)
 - **Every 2 Weeks:** Amanda, Arlington (Amanda to Brownsville), John, Locust, Stamm, Sherman, Walnut (Brownsville to Locust), Church (Anthony to Walter), Walter, Carl, Mary, Louisa (Ormsby to Margaret)
 - **Every 3 Weeks:** Moye, Koehler, Fremont, Frederick, Walnut (Locust to Frederick), Penn, St. Joseph, School

*****Note: There was some deviation from the regular schedule this month due to the extreme amount of snowfall.***

- Patched pot holes on Hays, Ormsby, Ottillia, Penn, St. Joseph, Margaret, Hervey, & Quincy.

Park Maintenance:

- Emptied trash cans/spot sweep 2x's per week.

Tree / Right of Way Maintenance:

- Removed fallen tree on Brownsville.

Grass Maintenance:

Sanitary/Storm Sewer Maintenance:

- Performed (4) Dye Test for the month of February.
- Cleaned inlets around Borough.
- Continuing to coordinate with property management agency and Allegheny County Health Department to abate the illicit discharge at 125 Margaret Street; Repairs are now in progress.

Vehicles & Equipment:

- Performed routine vehicle maintenance.
- Both the 2003 F-550 and 2007 Chevy 3500 had to undergo significant maintenance and repair this month due to their prolonged and heavy use from salting and plowing; The 2019 F-550 also had to be serviced after the dump bed become stuck in the up position.
- As of 2/28, all vehicles are in service.
